5. **Indian Space Sector - Snapshot**

The Indian space sector, currently valued at USD 8.4 billion, holds a modest 2-3% share of the global space economy. However, projections suggest that by 2033, India's space industry could expand to USD 44 billion, with exports contributing USD 11 billion- further positioning India as a key player in the global arena (Source: 'Decadal Vision and Strategy for the Development of the Indian Space Economy' report published by IN-SPACE in September 2023).
