Revised instruction/guidelines on "Re-issue of OCI cards due to issuance of new foreign passports to OCI cardholders"

- (i) OCI cardholder is required to get the OCI card re-issued only <u>once</u> when a new passport is issued after completing 20 years of age. (Applicants may visit our website www.indembassybern.gov.in (Consular Services OCI Cards General Instructions for Re-issue of OCI card) for the process). The fees for this is CHF 24 and CHF 3.
- (ii) OCI cardholder is required to **upload ONLINE** a copy of the **new passport and** a <u>latest photo each time</u> a new passport is issued up to 20 years of age and <u>once</u> after completing 50 years of age. The uploading of these documents may be done within <u>three months</u> of receipt of the new passport.
- (iii) Foreign Spouse of an Indian Citizen or spouse of foreign origin of an OCI cardholder are required to upload <u>a copy of the new passport</u> and also a latest photo ONLINE <u>each time</u> a new passport is issued along with <u>a declaration on subsisting of marriage, copy of the Indian passport of the Indian spouse/passport & OCI card of the OCI cardholder spouse.</u>

In case of (ii) and (iii), please visit https://ociservices.gov.in/welcome and select the option 'OCI Miscellaneous Services' for uploading copy of the passport, recent photograph and other documents. This does not involve any submission of documents to the Embassy and will be Gratis.

Once the application is granted, the new passport details shall be updated into the OCI system records and an acknowledgment shall be shared with OCI card holder on his/her registered email ID.

In this case there is no re-issue of OCI card, applicant may travel on the strength of his/her existing OCI card bearing old passport number along with the new passport.
