Revised Guidelines for International Arrivals w.e.f. 22nd November 2022

The new Covid travel guidelines issued from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India for International Arrivals to enter India with effect from 22.11.2022 are as follows:

Before the travel

- All travellers should preferably be fully vaccinated as per the approved primary schedule of vaccination against COVID-19 in their Country.

During Travel

- Preferable use of masks and physical distancing.
- Any passenger having symptoms of COVID-19 during travel shall be isolated as per standard protocol that is, the said passenger should be wearing mask, isolated and segregated from other passengers in flight/travel and shifted to an isolation facility subsequently for follow up treatment.

On Arrival

- On arrival, Thermal screening should be done in respect of all the passengers by the health officials present at the point of entry.
- The passengers found to be symptomatic during screening shall be immediately isolated, taken to a designated medical facility as per health protocol.
- Call National helpline number (1075)/ State Helpline Number in case of any symptoms suggestive.

2. Further, in view of the aforementioned MoHFW revised guidelines, international passengers travelling to India will **no longer be required** to submit online Air Suvidha Self Declaration Form. Consequently, **no RT-PCR test prior to travel is necessary.**
